Negotiation Tips for Employers: Volume commitments lower per-hire fees significantly. Offering exclusivity for 7–14 days before going to multiple agencies improves quality of candidate shortlists. Always clarify the replacement guarantee period, definition of 'leaving' (resignation vs. termination), and payment trigger date in the agreement.

Candidate Advisory:

Legitimate recruitment agencies in Ahmedabad never charge job-seekers for permanent placement services. Any agency demanding registration fees, interview preparation charges, or 'placement deposits' from candidates should be avoided and reported to the local labour office. Free career resources include government Employment Exchanges, college placement cells, and job fairs organised by CII Western Region and FICCI Gujarat.

- **Ask for a company brief and JD** before every interview so you walk in prepared, not cold.
- **Follow up after every interview round** to give the agency structured feedback — this helps them manage the employer relationship and advocate effectively for your candidacy.
